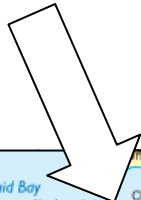

CHArt Society and the Lawrence House Museum invite you to a celebration of our shipbuilding heritage at the 24th Annual Maitland Launch Day Festival.

Join us in the Village of Maitland on August 21, 2010 to commemorate the launch of the W.D. Lawrence, the largest wooden hulled, full-rigged vessel ever built in Canada, and the third largest in the world! Villagers will be dressed in their Victorian best while displays and demonstrations of traditional skills and crafts take place throughout the day.

Events include a non-motorized, costumed processional through the village to the home of the shipbuilder, a re-enactment of the Launch using a 17-foot scale model of the ship, and a re-enactment of the Banishment of the Whiskey Peddler. All events NO CHARGE except where noted (\$\$), however good-will donations will be gratefully accepted at the performance tent.
